

This half term our topic is

## World War II

We will be learning about the impact of the war on our lives nationally and internationally. The significant turning point in British history.

### Literacy

We will be exploring the following text types:

Amelia Earhart - Biography  
What I Like! - Poetry.

We will learning to use passed tenses while writing a biography on our chosen person.

Through poetry we will using our senses and identify nouns and verbs and how to present our work both verbally and in written form.

### Maths

We will continue to work and develop our knowledge on multiplication and division. Then begin to study measurement using length and height.

### Science

We will be continuing to learn about materials using investigations to understand the properties of everyday materials.

### Art

This half term we will be studying the work of Kandinsky and his use of colour to express his emotions.

### Religious Education

The children will consider the meaning of a range of forms of religious expressions and make links between them.

### PSHE

This half term our focus is drug, alcohol and tobacco education. We will be looking at medicines why we take them and how to keep safe around medicine. We will also be exploring the impact of smoking.

### Music

Our focus piece of music this half term is Three Little Birds by Bob Marley and exploring Reggae tunes.

### ICT

The children will be using i-pads for animation programmes to make moving images.

### Physical Education

To participate in competitive team games including hockey and handball

### History

Through this topic we will studying the build-up to the war, the impact both nationally and internationally and the changes after the war.

### Experiences

This half term the children will be 'Digging for Britain' - beginning to produce a vegetable patch.

We will be organising a visit to Exeter covering the 'Blitz' and a trip to Bovington Tank Museum.
