

This half term our topic is

Walking with Dinosaurs

Literacy

We will be exploring the following text types:

Don't Spill the Milk
Dino Dinner

We will be developing our story mapping, writing our own stories with a twist at the end while focusing on sentence structure, capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will also be looking at non-fiction books and develop our own non-fiction based on our topic dinosaurs.

Maths

We will be working on place value, the children will identify and represent numbers, compare and order numbers and to describe amounts using 'more than', 'less than', 'equal to' or to use symbols to compare amounts of numbers.

Science

Within science Key Stage 1 children learning about Animals including humans.
Animals and their offspring.
Basic needs of animals and humans.
Importance of exercise diet and hygiene for humans.

Art

This half term our focus is sculpture and using different materials and tools to create a range of work.

Religious Education

Key Stage 1 children will be focusing on Christianity and Judaism linked to special people, objects, music, celebration and seasons within our lives.

Our main focus this half term is 'Myself' and what makes us special.

PSHE

We will be discussing friendships and through a variety of activities.

Music

Our focus piece of music this half term is called "Hey You!"

We will be learning to find the beat and keeping in time to the music.
