

This half term our topic is

Where in the World

English

Our first book is *Snail and the Whale*. We will be writing in the past tense, using a range of coordinating conjunctions and creating our own story based on the text.

Our second book will be *Hodgeheg* - we will be discussing the book and creating a poster.

Maths

In Foundation Stage, we will be working on shapes, number bonds, addition, subtraction, doubling and halving.

In Year 1 we will be describing shapes, place value within 20 and continuing to work on addition and subtraction.

In Year 2, we will be describing shapes, exploring money, and looking at multiplication and division.

Science

We are observing the four seasons and will create a seasons collage. We will go outside to experience the wind and make a wind sock.

We will discuss the importance of the sun, design sun catchers and a sundial for the garden, as well as exploring shadows using torches. We will be making a shadow theatre.

Art

KS1, alongside KS2, will be studying artists around the world. They will be producing their own self-portraits, drawing with exaggerated features in the style of Frida Kahlo; experimenting with printing techniques with Katsushika Hokusai; and still life drawings in the style of Ben Nicholson.

Me and Others - Looking at our identity, diversity and equality within society. Completing online activities focussed on positive wellbeing and mental health.

Whole school focus on learning basic BSL to enhance our awareness of others.

We will be creating and publishing a project using various software functions including *Google Earth*, *Word* and *Publisher*.
