

What should Remote Education look like?

The Department for Education has produced guidance for every school setting that outlines the statutory expectations.

Schools should set meaningful and ambitious work each day in several subjects.

Schools should promote remote education that includes either pre-recorded or live direct teaching.

Ofsted expect:

- 3 hours for KS1
- 4 hours for KS2
- 5 hours for KS3 and KS4
- KS5 to be inline where possible with the f.e. ambition to deliver as much of the students' planned hours as possible.

All of the above should include both direct teaching and time for pupils to complete tasks or assignments independently.
