# Our Blue Planet

## Literacy

We will be exploring the following text types:

One Day on this Blue Planet - developing our understanding of sequences events and comparing fiction to non - fiction.

Lost and Found - developing our story telling skills.

Water Protectors - stories from around the world.

## Maths

The children are focusing on place value and number formation and the meaning of a number.

Later in the term we continue to learn addition and subtraction.

## Science

Through our Discovery Walks and our lessons in class we will be looking at.

- 1) living things and their habitats.
- 2) Seasonal changes with regard to the changes in nature that we can see and feel around us, and the changes in the weather as we head into winter.

## Art/Design and Technology

We are learning to develop our printing through Aboriginal art and then exploring hot and cold colours and mixing.

## Religious Education

This half term, we are focussing on the Christian story of Creation from Genesis, and looking at the world around us.  
We will then look at the meaning of Christmas for Christians in the second half term.

## PSHE

This term our themes are Fun Times, linked to physical health and wellbeing. We will then be looking at Feeling Safe and Managing Risks.

## Music

Our theme is Hey You, where we will continue to develop our musical skills and language.

We will also have an opportunity to listen to traditional music from the world to discuss.

## ICT

This term the children will be learning about online safety and copywrite.

## Physical Education

We will be learning to find a space, travel in a range of styles and developing our ball skills through different activities.

## History/Geography

We are learning about the continents and oceans and hot and cold places around the world. Later in the term we will be looking at a significant explorer.
