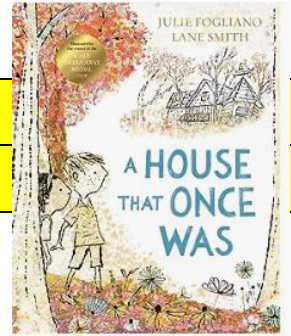

<p>Reading Links</p>	<p>This term’s focus for our guided reading sessions is on: Inference and Prediction. With the Year 6 children we will also be working sometimes on SATs questions to start preparing for the sort of answers needed in the Year 6 SATs in May. 	buildings locally. We will also look at how the inside of a house has changed throughout a long time period using artefacts to support this learning.
